

## OVERDUE PAYMENTS

Semester and final grades will be withheld until all payments are current. No student may be enrolled in a new semester unless all previous semester payments have been made. For payments returned because of insufficient funds, the school will assess a \$20.00 service charge. A \$5.00 per week late fee may also be assessed by the school for overdue accounts. Student transcripts/records will be released only after the account has been paid in full.

## EARLY WITHDRAWAL

If a student is withdrawn during a semester, the full semester's tuition is due.

## FINANCIAL AID

A limited amount of financial aid is available to families who otherwise may not be able to attend LCS. This assistance is based on financial need. The application process includes completing a confidential financial statement, which is filed electronically or mailed by the family directly to Family Financial Needs Assessment, Inc. This third party service informs the school of the amount of assistance for which the family qualifies. The level of assistance granted is based on the FFNA recommendation and the total amount of resources available.

Families requesting financial aid should contact the Business Office for information and application forms. **Following acceptance, applications may be submitted and must meet the April 1st deadline.**

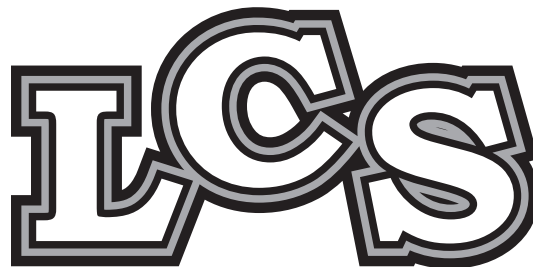
