

Application Procedures (International Student)

1. Complete the online application and submit the application fee to LCS (\$150, nonrefundable).
2. Send in required documents. LCS must receive these forms prior to granting an interview.
 - Copy of passport
 - Official SLATE-plus score report (or TOEFL/SLEP)
 - Official transcripts, with English translation, from past 2 years
 - References (English teacher, Math teacher, pastor/personal)
 - Official copy of bank statement with sufficient funds for tuition and fees
3. The International Student Coordinator will contact you to set up an interview in English via Skype.
4. A decision will be made regarding admission to LCS, based on the student application and interview. If approved, LCS will create an I-20 form and send it with the letter of acceptance.
5. Complete the visa application procedures at the Embassy in your home country.
6. Pay tuition in full prior to start of the school year/semester. Failure to do so may result in the I-20 being cancelled.
7. Before the start of classes, provide the following documents to LCS.
 - Copy of visa
 - Current physical exam (DH-3040)
 - Immunization verification form (DH-680)—only available from a Florida physician
 - Medical treatment authorization form
 - Proof of medical insurance
8. Provide LCS with your travel plans.
9. Plan to arrive in Lakeland, Florida for orientation during the week before the semester begins.

Note: LCS does not provide housing for students. Students who will not be living with a family member should contact the International Student Program Coordinator to receive a list of approved homestay agencies before beginning the application process.
