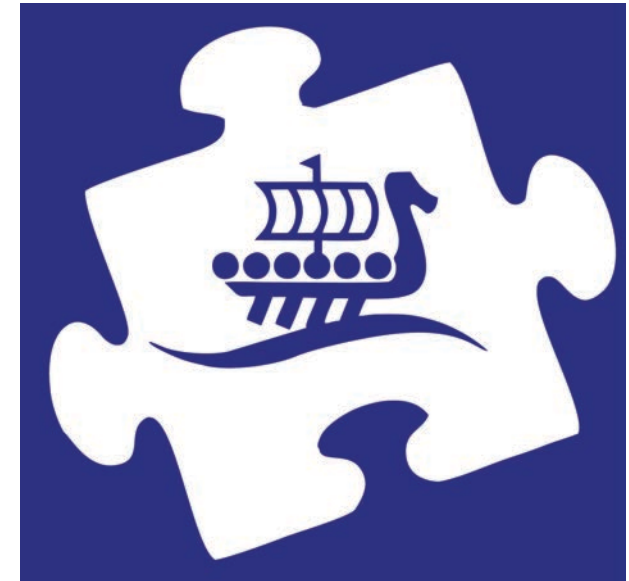

The Lakeland Christian School Discovery Program is an educational program for students with a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) or related disorder characterized by similar traits as ASD who require a modified academic setting.

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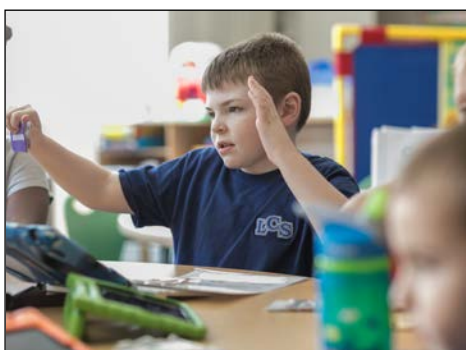
About the Lakeland Christian School Discovery Program

The Discovery Program consists of two self-contained classrooms offered to students with a specific diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) or related disorder characterized by similar traits as ASD who require a modified academic setting.

- Offered to ages 4*-14
*(*age appropriateness is based on the discretion of the Admissions team)*
- 1:4 Teacher/Student Ratio
- State Certified Teachers with Autism Endorsement
- Unique Learning Curriculum
- Academic focus in the following areas:
 - Reading, Writing, Math
 - Independent Functioning
 - Communication
 - Social Skills
 - Job Skills
- Inclusion Opportunities/Inclusion Paraprofessional Based on Student Needs
- McKay and Gardiner Scholarship Accepted
- Financial Aid Available
- Speech/Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Tutoring Provided
- Sensory Room Available Based on Student Needs

Each child in the Discovery Program has a current IEP. An annual staffing will be held to discuss needs and goals. Benchmarks will be completed in the classroom three times per year and a report will be provided to you. Students in level 2-4 will have an individually designed life and social skills program that will focus on self-care, job skills, money concepts, identifying personal information, scheduling concepts, community safety, and integration.

An applied behavior analyst or applied behavior assistant partners with our Discovery Program as a resource to observe students, provide therapy to students, and provide professional development on an as needed basis. ABA support may require an additional charge if a student needs to access this on a regular basis.



Program Levels

Level 1 - The student is able to participate in all academics and Specials in the general education classroom. OT is provided on campus. Sensory breaks will be provided as needed. The Discovery teacher will meet with the team of teachers to assure the child is meeting/exceeding goals in the general education classroom. **\$13,500**

Level 2 - The student will receive a custom academic schedule (reading, math, writing/language, science, and/or social studies) in the Discovery classroom and in the general education classroom. The student will participate in most of the general education Specials (PE, art, music, recess, chapel) with minimal inclusion-para support. **\$18,400**

Level 3 - The student is in the Discovery classroom for all academics as well as social and life skills training. The child will have opportunities for inclusion with general education peers. Inclusion-para support is needed during Specials. **\$20,850**

Level 4 - The student is in the Discovery classroom for the full day. **\$23,300**

Discovery Summer Program

The summer program for Discovery consists of four weeks total. Specific dates will be determined by mid-March each year. The summer days run from 8:00 AM - 1:30 PM. **\$2,400**
