### Parent Meeting & Orientation: Monday, August 7

Parents of ALL K4-5th grade students should attend parent orientation on August 7.

ALL K4-5th grade parents should plan to attend a mandatory Lower School Parent Partnership Meeting at 2:15 PM or 6:30 PM in the cafeteria.

Classroom sessions with teachers will be held at **3:00 PM, 4:15 PM or 5:30 PM**. New and returning families are encouraged to attend one of these sessions (one session for each of your Lower School children). These sessions will be held in the teachers' classrooms and should not last more than 50 minutes. Feel free to bring supplies on this night or during the Meet the Teacher time on August 8. Bibles and agendas will be distributed at these sessions.

- If you would like to meet the Special Area teachers (PE, art, music, library), please attend a session in the Lower School Art Room (E185) at 3:00 PM, 4:15 PM or 5:30 PM
- Special Programs and Discovery teachers will be available for parents to drop in and say hello from 3:00-6:30 PM. The teachers will communicate with you as we approach orientation.

All Lower School parents\* are strongly encouraged to attend one session. The same information will be presented in each session. If you have children in multiple grade levels, this will allow you to visit all of the sessions. If you have more than three children in Lower School, please contact Mrs. O'Byrne (lobyrne@lcsonline.org) to determine which grade levels to visit.

#### **Meet The Teacher Day: Tuesday, August 8**

**9:00-10:30 AM** - Parents and students in K4 through 5th are are invited to come meet their teacher(s), drop off supplies, take pictures (some choose to wear a uniform shirt), and get comfortable with the route from carline to the playground/classroom. If you ordered a school supply pack online, it will be delivered to your child's homeroom class. Students can come meet the Special Area teachers in the Lower School Art Room (E185). \* Because parents do not accompany their children into the classroom on the first day of school, this is the time to take pictures of your child in the classroom if you would like to do so. (Some children even wear their LCS shirt for pictures).

### First Day of School (Gr. K4-12): Wednesday, August 9

Wednesday, August 9, is the first day of school for all students. Parents, please pull through carline to drop off or pick up your child. You will be given specific information about the Lower School Dismissal Management app that will be used at dismissal and for After School Supervision for K4-5th grades. All grade levels will use it when your child is absent, tardy or checking out early. Lower school students will also need a carline cling. It is very important for you to read and abide by the dismissal guidelines that will be given to you prior to the first day of school.
