CORE VALUE #1: CHRIST-CENTERED COMMUNITY

The community we experience at LCS is much deeper than just belonging to an institution—we are members of the body of Christ! Jesus is the head, and in our relationships we seek to bring glory to him.

CORE VALUE #2: WISDOM THROUGH LEARNING

At LCS our goal extends far beyond merely getting good grades. We seek to impart wisdom so that children may live life with skill in God's kingdom.

WHAT DOES THIS LOOK LIKE?

Examples for Faculty:

- Treating you and your child with care and respect
- Communicating in love
- Keeping you informed through weekly communication
- Responding to communication from you by the end of the following school day
- Consistently enforcing school policies
- Seeking to resolve conflict or unmet expectations in light of the gospel, being willing to listen and work toward restoration/redemption.

Examples for Parents:

- Treating members of the LCS community with care and respect
- Communicating in love
- Reading communication from the school and responding when appropriate
- Supporting school policies
- Supporting LCS in public forums
- Seeking to resolve conflict or unmet expectations in light of the gospel, being willing to listen and work toward restoration/redemption.

Examples for Faculty:

- Maintaining a quality academic program, approaching every subject in the light of God's Word.
- Facilitating your child's academic, social, emotional, and spiritual growth.
- Teaching your child to use technology with wisdom
- Viewing disappointments and failures as opportunities for growth.

Examples for Parents:

- Establishing daily morning and after-school routines that facilitate your child's academic, social, emotional and spiritual growth.
- Prioritizing school attendance and punctuality.
- Monitoring your child's use of technology.
- Viewing disappointments and failures as opportunities for growth.

Examples for Faculty:

- Praying for your family and your child by name.
- Teaching the gospel to your child.
- Teaching your child how to live with humility, love, and kindness in the kingdom of God.
- Teach the truth of God's Word daily.
- Providing opportunities for your child to worship
- Helping your child identify and use the gifts the Lord has given him or her to further His kingdom.
- Protecting your family's opportunity to attend mid-week church services by refraining from assigning homework on Wednesdays or administering tests on Thursdays.

Examples for Parents:

- Praying with your child for the teacher(s) and the school.
- Teaching the gospel to your child.
- Teaching your child how to live with humility, love, and kindness in the kingdom of God.
- Developing a consistent pattern of teaching and discussing the Word of God with your children.
- Worshipping in church every week, placing your family under the teaching of the Word of God.
